Preparation for the Home Shrine Dedication

The choice of a place (pg 93) – A central place where it can be seen.

The essential elements of the Home Shrine (pg 92) – The MTA picture, a crucifix, a picture or symbol of the Original Schoenstatt Shrine or Daughter Shrine, a picture of Fr. Kentenich

The name of your Home Shrine (pgs 62-77) – The specific mission, need, unique activity & graces of the Blessed Mother for your family. You will want to display this name somewhere in your Home Shrine.

The symbols in the Home Shrine – a Living Shrine (pgs 80-90) - I live my part of the Home Shrine = I live my symbol in the Home Shrine. I need to find a symbol which expresses what I feel, live, and am. Then, I can relate to this particular symbol on an existential level, not just as a nice, religious idea.

The Home Shrine prayer (pgs 58-59,124) – a founding document and a suggested outline.

The spiritual preparation and blessings of a Home Shrine dedication (pgs 98-99) – a Novena is also available for a handout.

The actual celebration of the Home Shrine dedication (pgs 95-97) – a simple form or a prayer service, or Holy Mass in the home.
